Option A: Small Classroom Configurations: Under this option, funding will be used for the purchase of: desktops, printers, networking equipment, security devices, computer desks, chairs as needed for multiple classroom environments.
Option B: Presentation Stations: Schools can choose to use their RESO A funding to purchase interactive white board (i.e. SMART, Promethean), projection displays, active response systems, interactive wireless slates, and document cameras for the classrooms.
Option C: Specialized Adaptive Equipment: Schools can choose to use their RESO A funding to purchase capital eligible special education adaptive hardware (i.e. Attainment stations) and adaptive learning devices for special education classrooms.
Option D: Existing Lab Upgrade: Under this option, funds will be spent to refresh computers, peripherals, networking equipment, security devices, computer desks, and chairs in an existing computer lab (functioning data cabling & electric), using a template to assure timely completion.
Option E: Upgrade Cabling & Electrification: Schools can choose to use their RESO A funding to request a layout reconfiguration of the existing data cabling and electrical infrastructure in an existing computer lab to meet the school's instructional needs.
Option F: Create a New Computer Lab: **Approval from Space and Facilities Planning is required.** Schools can choose to use their RESO A funding to request that an existing classroom be converted into a new current computer lab environment with full data cabling and electrification.
